The estimated 770 000 [470 000–1 100 000] people dying from HIV globally in 2018 were 56% fewer than in 2004 (the peak) and 33% fewer than in 2010 in spite of a period of substantial population growth in many high burden countries. Nevertheless, there is no room for complacency. Countries need to live up to their commitment to end the AIDS epidemic as a public health threat by 2050 -- a target included in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in September 2015. The immediate challenge is to reach the Fast-Track targets for 2020, as HIV-related deaths are still unacceptably high. Global Data: Since the beginning of the HIV epidemic, more than 70 million individuals were infected approximately with the HIV virus and about 35 million people died of HIV. Universally, 36.9 million [31.1–43.9 million] people are living with HIV at the end of 2017. An expected 0.8% [0.6-0.9%] of adults aged 15–49 years affected with HIV, although the burden of the epidemic continues to vary considerably between countries and regions. The WHO African region remains most severely affected, with nearly 1 in every 25 adults (4.1%) living with HIV and accounting for nearly two-thirds of the people living with HIV worldwide. Business worth of HIV: In June 1981, scientists reported the first clinical evidence of a disease known as acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, or AIDS. Its cause, the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), was acknowledged in 1983. Since the start of the epidemic in 1981, around 75 million have become infected with HIV and around 32 million people have died of AIDS-related illnesses. In 2018, there were 37.9 million people living with HIV. New HIV infections have fallen by 16% since 2010 (by 41% among children) and AIDS-related deaths have fallen by 55% since the peak in 2004.
